Along with our individual practices, our communities will be offering three collective in-person creative worship opportunities at different points through the season:

Taizé Worship and Reflection – Miami Shores Presbyterian Church Chapel, Wednesday, February 28th, 7 pm "Stillness, Prayer, and Song"

Worship with the community in a contemplative way. Chant with the group and experience a deep level of centering, gratitude, and love with the community and the spirit of God.

Creative Movement and Body Prayer – Riviera Presbyterian Church, Sunday, March 10th, 3 pm "Movement is Life, and Life is Movement"

Each month, I will focus on a different task.

Task for Transitional Pastor: Renewing the Spiritual Life of the Congregation

Creative Spirits is a new effort that the Sessions at both Miami Shores Presbyterian Church and Riviera Presbyterian Church have agreed to try together. This is an experimental project that Rev. Melanie Marsh and I have been discerning and praying about for some time now. And, we are both excited to see what the Spirit might do with us in this time of creativity. The hope is that as we attempt to use our creativity – to go beyond the worship that we know – that we will experience something renewing with our God. Perhaps this will spark new ways to pray and new ways to be in community with God and each other. It will allow us to get out of our usual spaces, perhaps allowing new participants to enter into prayer with us. May the Spirit of God lead us in the season of renewal.

HOUSE OF HOPE

Supplies are starting to arrive and thanks are sent to MSPC from the House of Hope for ongoing prayers and financial support in 2023.

SAFESPACE

MSPC is partnering with Safespace, a new local mission partner. Safespace is a non-profit organization founded in 1978. They provide safety and support to victims of domestic violence and their children. They assist with a safe place to live, food, counseling, emergency assistance, information and referrals. The closest Safespace shelter is a few blocks from MSPC. They have 63 single beds and 14 cribs. Most people seeking refuge from domestic abuse stay at Safespace for 6-8 weeks.



Safespace is in constant need for the following items:

- Toiletries- Full size preferably
- Gently used children's and teen clothing and shoes
- Flip flops- All sizes

Bring your donations on the first Sunday of the month. A table will be set up in the breezeway. Please label the bag.


